Grants have been awarded through the FIPPOA Fund of Stonewall Community Foundation. In the summer of 1999, The Fire Island Pines Property Owners' Association (FIPPOA), created a community-wide fundraising event designed in part to strengthen and build the lesbian and gay organizations serving the New York community. We thank them for their generosity, creativity and vision. Nearly \$900,000 has been awarded to 26 grantees.
